Questions:

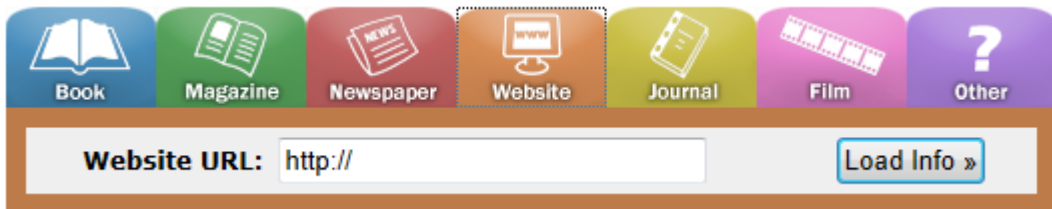
1. Definition of slope (include both mathematical and general)

To use Bibme.

1. Go to the site <http://www.bibme.org/>.
2. You will be required to register on this site. Each time you use the site you will be required to log on.
3. Click on the tab “Website”



4. Copy and paste the url of the site you are using for information or pictures into the fill line next to “ Website URL”. Be careful not to include the <http://> twice.



- Once the URL has been pasted into the fill line click on the button "Load Info". You will see the info as indicated below. If the information does not appear copy the URL to the line "Website URL" and fill in as much information as possible.

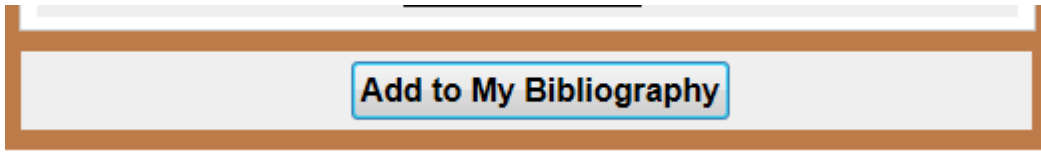
